2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines / Federal Poverty Levels

If you want to see what 400% of the poverty level is, you can multiply the 100% Federal Poverty Level dollar amount by 4.00 (so for a 1 person household it is \$11,880 x 4.00 = \$47,520). For 300% FPL multiply by 3.00. For 250% FPL multiply by 2.50. For 138% FPL multiply by 1.38 etc.
