The colors are vivid but not too rich like normal medieval decks. That allows it to be a lighter deck and more open to interpretation. I believe it helps to develop intuition. This is not a dark or heavy deck in any sense of the word, for there are no violent or bloody pictures. The minor cards are illustrated, unlike the visconti-sforza, making it easier to read. The cards are a little bigger than normal decks and have a nice sheen, without being overly glossy.
